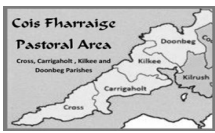

JUBILEE YEAR 2025

The Jubilee has its origins in an ancient biblical tradition (*Leviticus*). Every 50th year was celebrated as a time for setting slaves free, for forgiving debts, and for allowing the land to rest. In our Christian tradition the Jubilee has a strong focus on reconciliation and renewal, including reaching out to people on the margins. It is normally celebrated every 25 years, so that more people can celebrate it at least once in a lifetime. During the year some special events will be taking place in our parishes, diocese and particularly in Rome that will help us mark this Jubilee Year.

"May the grace of the Jubilee reawaken in us, Pilgrims of Hope, a yearning for the treasures of heaven.

May that same grace spread the joy and peace of our Redeemer throughout the earth.

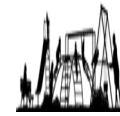
